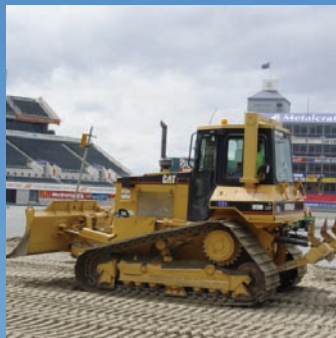
TIC Golf Projects Ltd manages the construction of new golf courses and re-construction of existing courses.

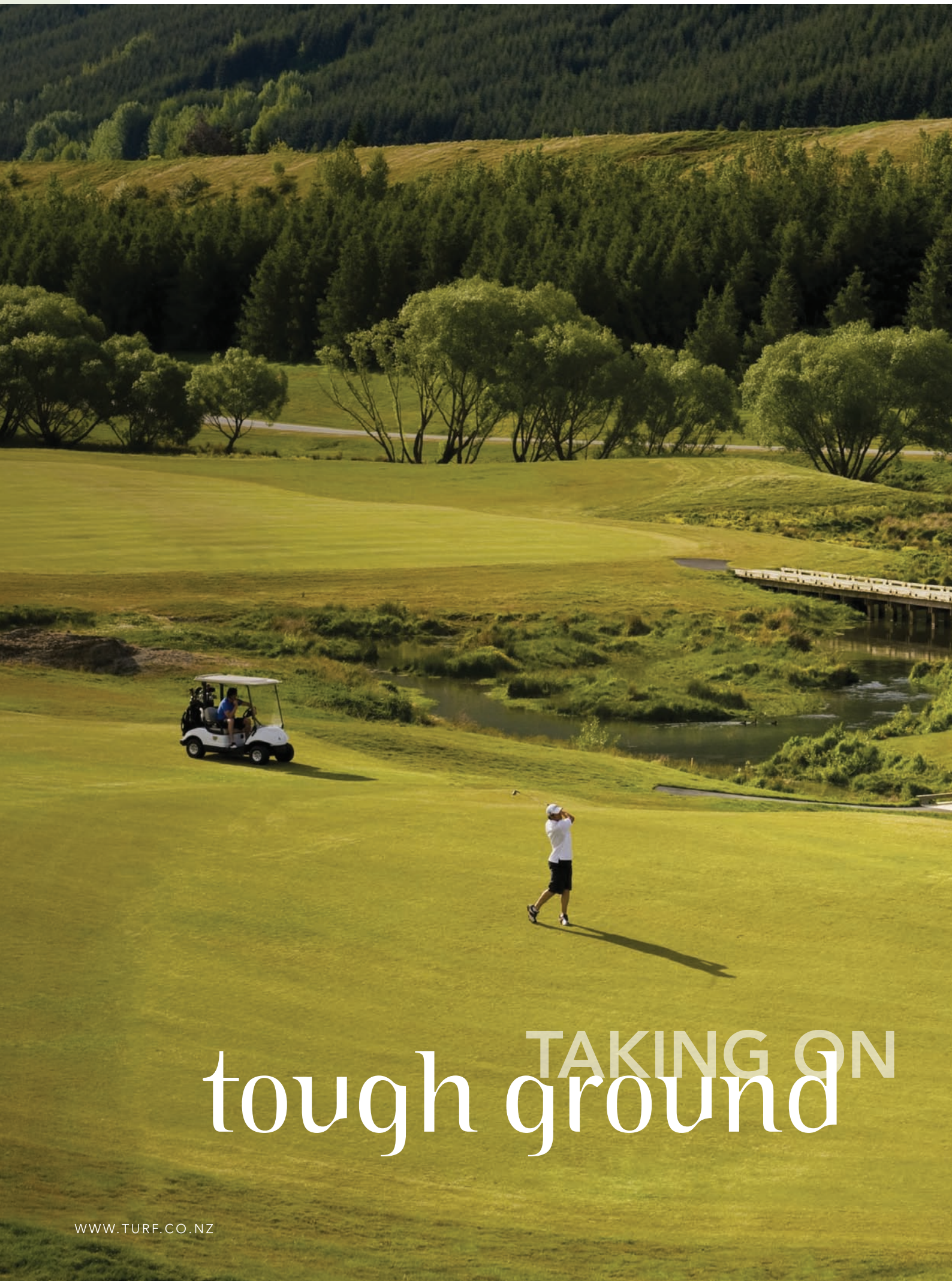

MILLBROOK CORONET 9

27 Hole Golf Course

Arrowtown

Central Otago



In an alpine environment at an altitude of 392 metres, the golf course at Millbrook features a variety of grasses and cut heights, all manicured for technically and visually exciting golf. The 'Coronet Nine' will form part of three 18-hole combinations, where any two out of the three 'nines' can be played together, flowing through a new half billion dollar resort homes development. TIC Projects - Brief:

Expanding on the existing 18 holes to allow further residential development of 59 house sites. 'Coronet 9': 9 newly constructed championship golf holes at 'Millbrook West Stage 1 Development'. Plus 4 holes from the original Bob Charles designed 18 hole course received extensive re-configuration and re-alignment.

Construction Challenges:

- Completing the works to the required, tight timeframes
- Winter conditions under perma frost / ice and snow





KINLOCH

18 Hole Golf Course

Kinloch
Lake Taupo

The signature Jack Nicklaus designed course at Kinloch was completed in May 2007 and voted one of the top 10 new golf courses in the world the same year by US Travel and Leisure magazine. The course rumbles across a dramatically undulating landscape punctuated by exposed rock – overlooking the moody Lake Taupo. It's fairways are contoured and conditioned for ground play and flecked with disheveled bunkers. For more information go to www.kinloch-golf.co.nz

TIC Projects - Brief:

Once the shaping was completed TIC Projects was involved in the full construction process of the Kinloch golf course including installation of the full course irrigation and drainage systems. TIC projects also provided machinery and operators to assist in the construction of the greens, tees, bunkers, fairways and lakes, as well as the finishing and preparation of the fairways, rough and out of play areas, and the seeding of the course and subdivision areas. Working alongside Kinloch staff and the Nicklaus international design and construction crew, meant sharing of knowledge and skills and the fostering of ongoing relationships.

Construction Challenges:

- Establishing a full team in a remote location for 2 ½ years
- Working on a pumice base
- Working with a high profile designer with high expectations
- Installation of highly specified computer controlled irrigation system

TIC Projects - Brief:

TIC Projects were employed to provide specialist shaping, drainage and construction services for the golf course features encompassing the greens, tees, bunkers, and fairways. TIC Projects have also completed the cricket oval and soccer fields at Jack's Point.

Construction Challenges:

- Minimal earthworks where required so as not to disturb the natural contours of the land
- Re-interpreting the golf course plan to accommodate the rock and rugged terrain
- Meeting the strict budget and timeline in an area with a relatively harsh climate
- Flat pipe drainage which was the first installation of this type across a full course

TIC Projects - Brief:

Our contract was to construct a turn key 18 hole international standard golf course with the handover in a playable condition.

Construction Challenges:

- To work around a large area of wetlands including reclaiming swampland
- The property is at the high tide mark which means it is prone to flooding which required some unique solutions to solve drainage issues across the site

North Shore Golf Club features 27 tree lined holes offering players three different 18 hole layouts. The scenic aspect of the club encompasses rural views poised above the natural backdrop of the Lucas Creek escarpment.

TIC Projects - Brief:

The reconstruction of 12 of the existing 18 holes after the removal of 250,000m³ of sand. This included a complete irrigation upgrade, tee and bunker rebuilding and some re-modelling of existing greens on the rest of the course.

Construction Challenges:

- Due to the need to excavate a large quantity of sand and to create lakes for the storage of irrigation water the golfing corridors were considerably reduced requiring careful planning of the new layout
- Hydromulching complete fairways to stop the seed from being blown out to sea

Work commenced in Feb 2011 and is programmed to take three years, while still allowing members to play 18 holes during the construction period.
